## **PUBLIC INFORMATION ARREST NOTIFICATION**

On June 3, 2020 a Deputy Inspector with the Office of Inspector General of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) arrested 26 year old Tori Landmesser, a former TJJD employee Improper Sexual Activity with a Person under Supervision. This is a state jail felony offense under the Texas Penal Code Chapter 39.04, which is punishable by up to a \$10,000.00 fine and a term of imprisonment in the Institutional Division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice of 180 days up to two (2) years if convicted.

The arrest warrant stemmed from an investigation conducted by the Office of Inspector General on an incident that occurred in May of 2020. Landmesser, while an employee of TJJD, engaged in sexual intercourse with an individual known to her to be under the supervision of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice and who was previously in the custody of TJJD. Landmesser was booked into the McLennan County Jail. The case was filed with the Special Prosecutions Unit. On December 3, 2020 Landmesser was indicted by the McLennan County Grand Jury for Improper Activity with a Person under Supervision, Cause Number 2020-2068-C1
