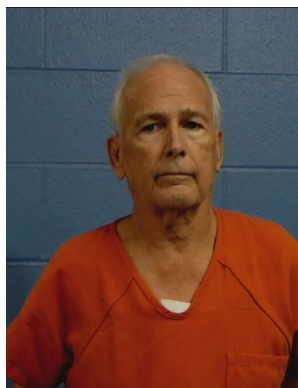

PUBLIC INFORMATION ARREST SUMMARY

On August 3, 2022, Inspectors with the Office of Inspector General (OIG) of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) executed an arrest warrant for John Allen Campau (71) in Cedar Park Texas, for Possession of Marijuana. The alleged offense is a Class A Misdemeanor under the Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 481.121, which is punishable by up to a \$4,000 fine and confinement in jail for any term of not to exceed 1 year.

This arrest warrant emanated from an incident that occurred at the Giddings State School in Giddings, Texas in July 2022. Campau while preparing to be searched to enter a secure correctional facility for a scheduled visitation discarded a small quantity of marijuana. OIG security officers discovered the marijuana and seized it as evidence. OIG inspectors conducted a criminal investigation resulting in the arrest of Campau. The case will be referred to the Special Prosecutions Unit.

The Office of Inspector General is the independent law enforcement agency that is statutorily responsible for investigating criminal allegations involving TJJD juveniles, TJJD employees, TJJD facilities, contractors, or programs of the Texas juvenile justice system.
