## **PUBLIC INFORMATION ARREST SUMMARY**

On November 26, 2019, Deputy Inspector Generals with the Office of Inspector General at the Texas Juvenile Justice Department obtained an arrest warrant for 62 year old Deborah Satchell a TJJD employee, for Misuse of Official Information. The alleged offense is a third degree felony under the Texas Penal Code Chapter 36.06, which is punishable by up to a \$10,000.00 fine and a term of imprisonment in the Institutional Division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice of two (2) years and up to ten (10) years if convicted.

This arrest warrant stemmed from an investigation conducted by the Inspector General's Office on an incident that occurred in September of 2019. Satchell, an employee of the TJJD, engaged in misuse of official information by providing confidential TJJD offender information to a unauthorized individual. On November 26, 2019, Satchell was arrested without incident and booked into the McLennan County Jail. This case will be filed with the Special Prosecution Unit.

The Office of the Inspector General is statutorily responsible to investigate criminal allegations involving TJJD youth, TJJD employees, or T.J.J.D. facilities.
