

**PUBLIC INFORMATION
ARREST NOTIFICATION**

On October 12, 2018, criminal investigators with the Office the Inspector General (OIG) at the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) arrested Juvenile Supervision Officer (JSO) Venus Anguay (30) on a felony warrant # F41327 for Improper Sexual Activity with a Person in Custody. Anguay was booked into the Brown County Jail by OIG investigators without incident. This offense is a Second Degree Felony under the Tex. Pen. Code Chapter § 39.04. If convicted, this offense is punishable by imprisonment in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for two to twenty years and a fine up to \$10,000.00. The arrest warrant stemmed from an investigation conducted by the OIG that involved allegations of misconduct by an employee at the TrueCore Behavioral Juvenile Facility, which is a contact care facility in Brownwood, Texas. The case will be prosecuted by the Brown County District Attorney.

The Office of the Inspector General is statutorily responsible to investigate criminal allegations involving T.J.J.D youth, employees, contractors, volunteers, or at T.J.J.D. or contact facilities. Investigators with the OIG also conduct abuse, neglect, and exploitation investigations at contract and county juvenile facilities and programs on behalf of the Department.
