On October 26, 2021, Daniel Holmes, a former TJJD employee, pled guilty to Violation of the Civil Rights of a Person in Custody; Improper Sexual Activity; Person in Custody (TX PC 39.04) and one count of Indecency with a Child - Lewd Exhibition (TX PC 21.11). In the plea agreement, Holmes acknowledged that both acts were committed while the victim was in secure confinement at a TJJD facility in Brown County. Holmes had previously been arrested by the OIG for Sexual Performance of a Child and Possession of Child Pornography for alleged acts following the victim's release on parole. In the guilty plea for both offenses, Holmes agreed to 6 years of deferred adjudication and community supervision. He will be required to register as a sex offender while on supervision and for an additional 10 years following the term of his probation, a \$600 fine, and perform community service.

The Office of the Inspector General is statutorily responsible to investigate criminal allegations involving TJJD youth, TJJD employees, or T.J.J.D. facilities. GUILTY
