

## Program Override Definitions

If you referred a juvenile to a program but he/she never participated, do not enter a Program Begin Date or a Program End Date/Outcome. Use the Program Status box near the top of the screen to indicate why the juvenile didn't participate.

If the juvenile began the program and then it was determined that he/she was not eligible to continue, close the Program by entering an End Date, End Time and Outcome (Unsuitable/Not Eligible).

### Program Override Status options:

#### ***Disapproved***

The Program refused to take the juvenile (decision made by Program or Department).

#### ***No Show***


The juvenile did not attend the scheduled session(s).

#### ***Refused by Parent***

The juvenile's parent(s) refused to allow the juvenile to participate (decision made by parent).

#### ***Exit***

Juvenile didn't attend for an OTHER reason (ex. Supervision ended before the juvenile attended the program).
