



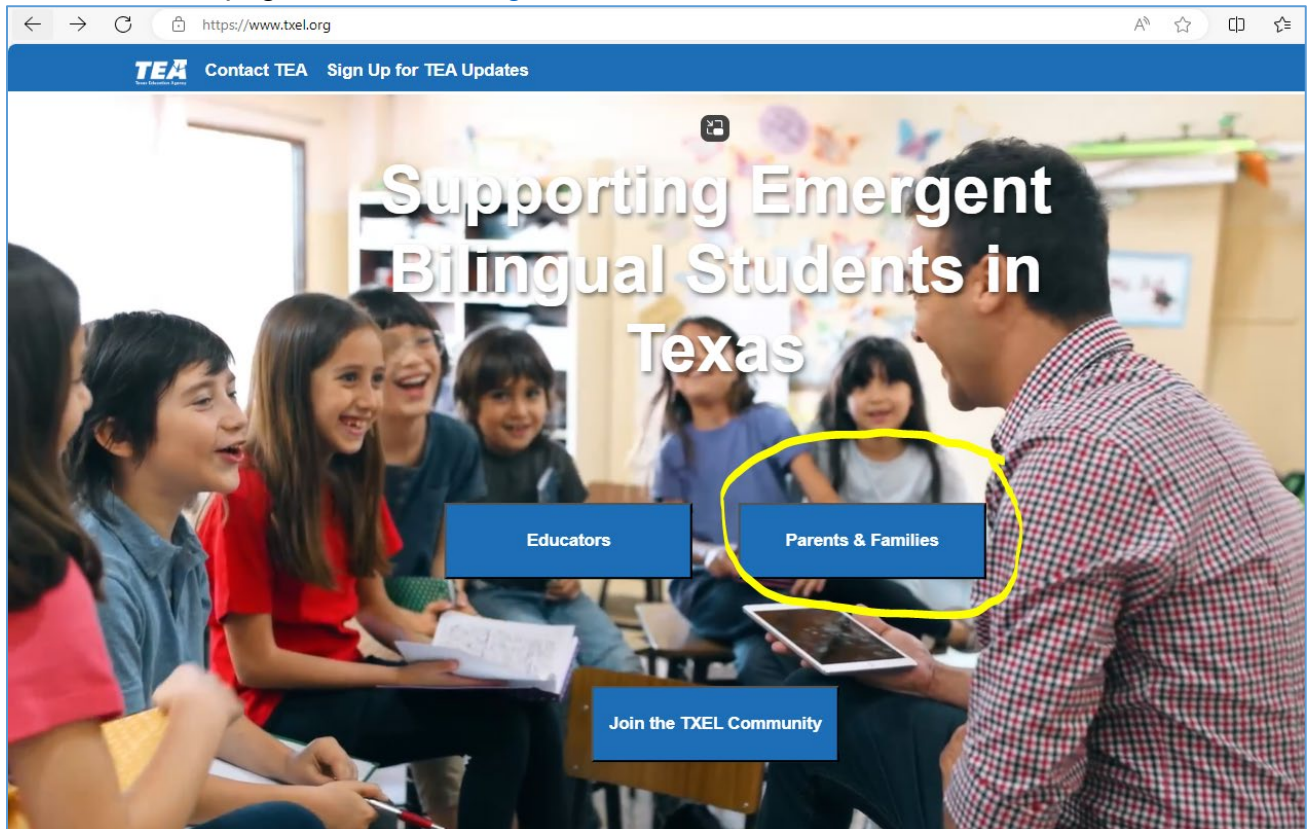
## Emergent Bilingual Family Resources

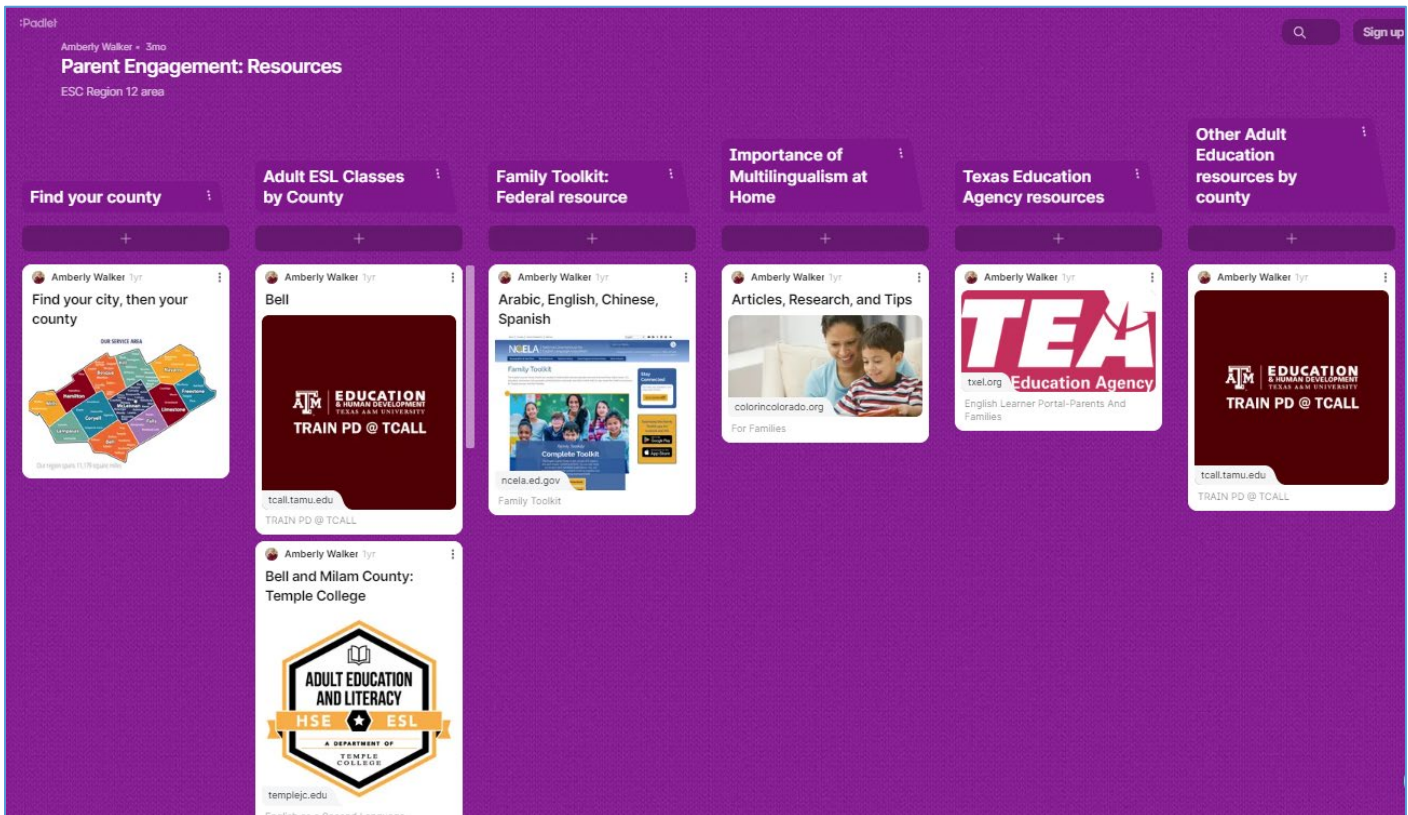
Next, select, “Subscribe to TXEL Portal”:
