



As part of the Texas Model implementation, TJJD has taken a large step toward increasing access to mental health care for all adjudicated youth. Approximately 80% of the youth in TJJD custody qualify as having a need for mental health services. Each of our secure facilities has licensed mental health care and specialized treatment providers available.

SECURE FACILITIES TREATMENT PROGRAMS

TREATMENT INTERVENTION PROGRAMS

Mental Health Interventions

Agency wide

- Youth identified with a mental health need receive services with licensed mental health providers available at all five secure facilities.
- Psychiatric services.

Mental Health Treatment Program (Giddings, TX)

- 32 bed unit with a ratio of 1:6.
- Weekly sessions with Mental Health clinicians who are housed on the units.

Crisis Stabilization Unit (Giddings, TX)

- 8 bed unit with a ratio of 1:4.
- Medical model, self-contained unit.
- Increased psychiatric and nursing oversight.

SPECIALIZED TREATMENT PROGRAMMING

Substance Use Services Treatment Program (SUS) - Agency Wide

Capital & Serious Violent Offenders Treatment Program (CSVOTP)

- Aggression Replacement Therapy (ART) – 12-week program
- Power Source (VOP) – 16-week program
- Capital Offender (COG) – 24-week program

Sexual Behavior Treatment Program (SBTP)

- Moderate – 14-week program
- High – 24-week program

Behavior Stabilization Unit (BSU)

- 2 self-contained 4 bed units with a 1:2 ratio
- Increased structure with individualized safety goals for youth

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT)
- Structured Psychotherapy for Adolescents Responding to Chronic Stress (SPARCS)
- Canine Support
- Specialized treatment programming for chronically aggressive youth.
- Vocational Training
- Educational Assistance
- Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics (NMT)
- Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR)
- Trust-Based Relational Intervention (TBRI)
